
Notes on the Cog 356 Final Exam

The following notes pertain to your **final exam** in this course.

1. The final exam will be distributed on Wednesday, April 20, 2022 (Part 1), and on Friday, April 22, 2022 (Part 2).
2. **The final exam is due on Thursday, May 12, 2022.**
3. The exam is a take home exam.
4. **It is expected that you will do all of the work on your exam without consulting any other person with respect to the problems on the exam.**
5. The exam is a two part exam:
 - (a) **Part 1: Critical Thinking about Cognitive Phenomena** - This part of the exam will ask you to write two essays, and then to evaluate each of the essays according to given rubrics.
 - (b) **Part 2: Formal Systems** - The featured topics for this part of the exam will be: (1) general ideas about formal systems, (2) Post production systems and related matters, as discussed in GEB, (3) simple Markov processes, (4) L-systems and fractals, (5) formal languages and context free grammars, (6) Lambda calculus.
6. What are you expected to submit?
 - (a) **Part 1: Critical Thinking about Cognitive Phenomena** - Submit one **pdf document** containing all of your work on this part of the exam.
 - (b) **Part 2: Formal Systems** - Submit one **pdf document** containing all of your work on this part of the exam.
