- Full Name- Avram Noam Chomsky
- Born December 7th, 1928 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania
- Born into a middle-class Jewish family.
- Married to Carol Chomsky, with 3 children.
- Linguist, Cognitive Scientist, Analytic Philosopher, and a Political Activist
- Often traveled to New York City as a kid to visit alternate book stores.



Biographical Sketch

- Attended the University at Pennsylvania.
 - Structuralism
 - “Syntax and phonology are matters of abstract representation”
- Junior Fellow of the Harvard society of fellows from 1951-1955
- Taught linguistics at Massachusetts Institute of Technology
- Professor at the university of Arizona
- Author of over 100 books

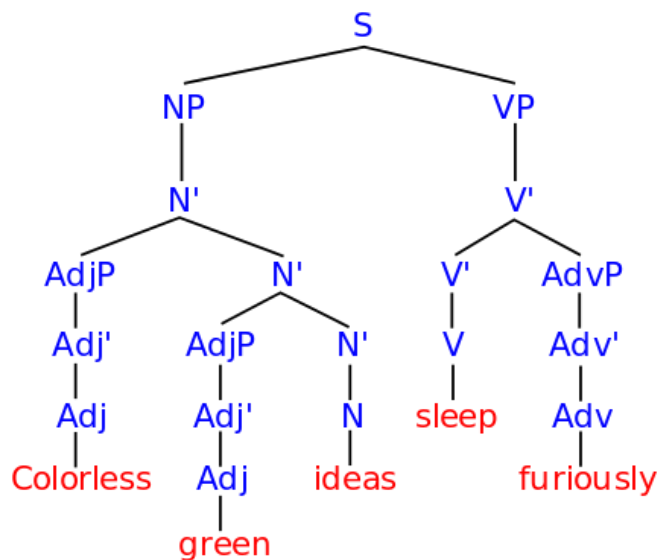


Phrase Structure Rules

Phrase structure rules generate structures.

- TP/S → • NP VP
- NP → • { Art (Adj+) N, Pro, PN }
- VP → • V NP (PP) (Adv)
- PP → • P NP

Generative grammar/Universal Grammar

- Classifies grammar as a system of rules
- Creates a combination of words that form grammatical sentences
- Humans languages are all structured on the same abstract template.
- Humans have a set of rules we follow that allow us to determine if something is grammatical
- Went against what had be previously been accepted.

Syntactic Structures

- Revised Lecture Notes
- Written in 1957 while at MIT
- Introduced his idea of Transformational Generative Grammar
- Phrase structure
 - Break down sentences into smaller piece
- Transformational Rules
 - Allow for different sentence structures

Chomsky Hierarchy

- Developed in 1956
- Broke down formal grammar into 4 different classes
 - Type -0 (most general)
 - Type -1
 - Type -2
 - Terminal symbols- symbols in language
 - Nonterminal symbols- symbols not in language
 - Type -3

The Hierarchy

Class	Grammars	Languages	Automaton
Type-0	Unrestricted	Recursive Enumerable	Turing Machine
Type-1	Context Sensitive	Context Sensitive	Linear-Bound
Type-2	Context Free	Context Free	Pushdown
Type-3	Regular	Regular	Finite

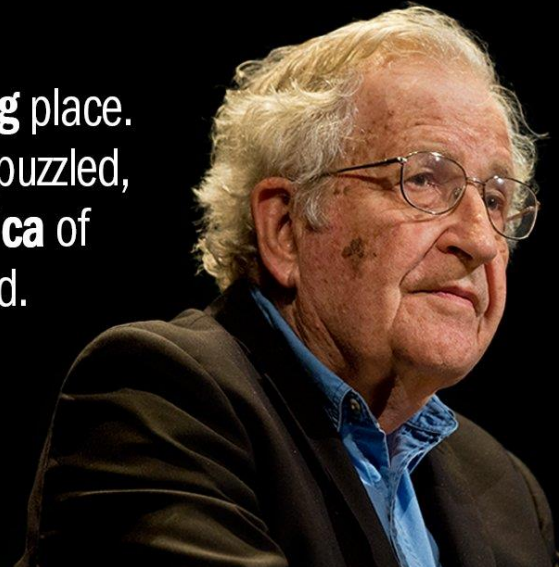
Quotes By Chomsky
